Ordeal Candidate Registration 2012

The cost of the Ordeal covers 2012 dues, Lodge flap (patch), OA sash, OA handbook, meals and Brotherhood sash (eligible to receive 10 months after completing Ordeal). Submit a complete registration, medical form, and fee to the OA Secretary. A bus option (\$35) is available for the Cima I and II Ordeals.

Medical Form: All candidates must have a completed Medical Form A&B (www.scouting.org/filestore/pdf/34605_Letter.pdf)

Late registrations: There is a late registration fee of \$25. Food is ordered one week before each Ordeal based on pre-registration numbers; as a result, late registrations are not guaranteed Saturday night dinner. Refunds are not given; however, rescheduling to another 2012 Ordeal is allowed if requested at least one week before the Ordeal.
