You can attend more than one weekend to collect all five CSP's. Service projects will include creating new campsites and clearing new programs areas for activities such as zip lines. Letters will be given to youth who need school service hours. Units or individual Arrowman (OA members) may register. Ordeals have been added to three SHAC Corps weekends. Arrowman elected into the OA during Fall 2011 elections may attend their Ordeal at the February, May, or June SHAC Corps weekends; candidates need to complete an ordeal registration form available at www.colonneh.org/ordeals.
